Reply has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 and 2 in the Court today. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the opposite counsel.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was involved in FIR No.101 dated 11.7.2013, registered under Sections 325, 323, 34 IPC at Police Station Cantt. Ferozepur and FIR No.3 dated 2.1.2018 registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Lakho Ke Behram, District Ferozepur. He further submits that FIR No.101 stands quashed by this Court vide judgment dated 28.3.2014 and in other FIR No.3, the petitioner stands acquitted by learned trial Court.

Heard.

In this view of the matter, without commenting on the merits of

the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to approach the competent authority i.e. respondent No.2-Passport Officer, Amritsar again to issue passport with complete documents within four weeks from today. In case, no deficiency is found in the documents, passport be issued to the petitioner within four weeks thereafter. However, in case any deficiency is noticed in the documents, before rejecting the case of the petitioner, he be afforded an opportunity of hearing.

Disposed of accordingly.
