Petitioner-Satinder Singh has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to official respondents to register FIR against respondent No.5. It is further prayed that the FIR be investigated through some independent agency/higher police official.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the fact that previously he had filed the petition for the same relief i.e. for transferring the investigation to some independent agency/higher agencies and the said prayer was declined by this Court vide order dated 07.01.2019 (Annexure P-5).

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the fact that upon his complaint, the cognizance has been taken. He submits that respondent No.5 has not been indicted as an accused in the said FIR. He does not dispute the fact that the complaint given by him on 09.02.2018 does mention the name of respondent No.5. Once the cognizance is already taken

by the Police, the prayer made by the petitioner for registering the FIR against respondent No.5 is misplaced particularly when the investigation of the case is pending.

This Court does not find any reason to invoke inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Resultantly, petition is dismissed.
