AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

On 25.01.2019, following order was passed:-

“It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the revision petition which has been preferred by the petitioner i.e. ROR No.105 of 2016, before the Financial Commissioner Revenue, Haryana, has till date not decided despite the parties having appeared before the said authority. She further states that the next date of hearing in the revision petition is 25.03.2019.

Let two copies of the writ petition be handed over to Mr. Pradeep Prakash Chahar, DAG, Haryana, during the course of the day under proper receipt, who shall seek instructions from respondent No.1 as to when the revision petition would be heard and decision taken thereon.

List on 01.02.2019 for consideration.”

Counsel for the State has referred to para 6 of the writ petition to point out that the dates have been mentioned as to when the case has been listed but the zimni orders have not been attached along with the same, which would indicate that as to whether the delay has been caused because of the petitioner or the respondents. He further states that he has instructions from the Financial Commissioner, Revenue, Haryana-respondent No.1 that

he would proceed to decide the revision petition within the time frame,

which may be fixed by this Court.

In the light of the fact that ROR No.105 of 2016 is fixed for hearing on 25.03.2019, the Financial Commissioner, Revenue, Haryana, shall make an endeavour to decide the same as early as possible and in any case not beyond a period of three months from the date already fixed in the revision petition.

With these observations, the writ petition stands disposed of.
