Petitioner is accused in as many as 13 complaints filed under
Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act.

furnish different bail bonds with one surety of the like amount in all the
cases.

HC Minu, has submitted that the petitioner has already mortgaged his entire
property with the bank and now he is not left with any other property. This
Court has further been informed that the petitioner is permanent resident of
the address given.

In view of the aforesaid fact, the present petition is disposed of
permitting the petitioner to furnish separate bail bonds. However, he shall
be permitted to submit one common surety in all the cases to the satisfaction
of the Trial Court.
