Through the present petition, petitioner lays challenge to the order dated 03.08.2019 cancelling bail bonds and surety bonds furnished by him as he did not appear in spite of notice given.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that personal appearance of the petitioner-accused was exempted and the Court had informed his counsel directing him to appear in person since case was fixed for arguments on charge. He submits that counsel did not further communicate the direction of the Court to the petitioner. Learned counsel submits that given an opportunity, the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and furnish fresh bail bonds with surety bonds of like amount.

In view of the aforesaid contention, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial

Court within 10 days and furnish fresh bail bonds and surety bonds of like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petitioner would also be required to file an affidavit to the effect that he would not remain absent on any date of hearing unless prior exemption from appearance has been granted.

This order is conditional and would enure to the benefit of the petitioner only if the petitioner complies with the undertaking.
