In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the claim of the petitioner for stepping up of his pay equivalent to his junior has been rejected in an arbitrary manner vide order dated 30.10.2015 (Annexure P-8). The prayer of the petitioner is that he be granted the benefit of step up of his pay equivalent to his junior and consequently his pensionary benefits be revised.

Learned counsel for the respondents at the outset informs that the claim of the petitioner has already been accepted by the respondents vide order dated 10.12.2018 (Annexure R-1) and the pay of the petitioner has already been stepped up equivalent to his junior and even the pensionary benefits have been revised and re-fixed. Learned counsel for the respondents on instructions from Sh. Dinesh Kumar, Assistant states that

even the arrears in respect of the grant of benefit, have also been released to the petitioner and no other benefit is left to be paid to the petitioner at this stage.

Prima-facie, the benefits for which the present writ petition has been filed, have already been released to the petitioner and the writ petition has been rendered infructuous. In case any of the benefit, for which petitioner feels that he is entitled for, but not released so far, petitioner will be at liberty to approach respondents by filing appropriate representation.

Present writ petition is disposed of in above terms.
