On 28.8.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Prayer in the petition is to grant anticipatory
bail to the petitioners in cross case DDR No.48 dated
29.05.2019 under Sections 452/323/34 IPC and Section
325 IPC added later on in FIR No.100 dated 28.05.2019
under Sections 341/323/427/148/149 IPC and Section
325 IPC added later on, registered at Police Station City
Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends
that cross case has been registered as a counter blast to
the criminal case registered vide FIR No.100. He further
submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated
in the case.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender
Beniwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State

of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Adjourned to 14.10.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 28.8.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
