Petitioner prays for quashing of criminal complaint filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act on the ground that the petitioner had resigned from accused No.1-company three months prior to the date the cheque in question was drawn.

Petitioner had filed a revision petition before the Court of Session and the learned Court of Session has noticed that the petitioner has not produced record from the office of Registrar of Companies to prove that his name had been deleted from the list of Directors of the company before the cheque in question was drawn.

The jurisdiction of the High Court while entertaining petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is limited. In such circumstances, petitioner is relegated to the remedy before the trial Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of.
