The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 230 dated 21.06.2019, under Sections 22, 25 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused Kaka Singh from whom tablets containing tramadol had been recovered. He also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case. No recovery has been effected from the petitioner.

This Court, by the order dated 12.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Karamjit Singh Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 12.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
