AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 29.08.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.11685 of 2016.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced as under:-

“In view of the ratio of the judgments referred above, the both the writ petitions are allowed with a directions to the respondents to regularize the services of both the petitioners i.e. Samunder Singh and Jagdish w.e.f. 01.10.2003 in view of policy/instructions dated 01.10.2003 and petitioners would not be entitled to any back wages, but will be entitled to benefit of continuity of services and other consequential benefits with a costs of Rs.25,000/- which is to be deposited

with the Registry of this Court. This exercise shall be completed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition as directions of this Court have been complied with. However, costs have not been deposited with the Registry.

Learned counsel for the respondents undertakes that costs shall be deposited with the Registry within two weeks from today but same is not being accepted as time has elapsed.

Time for deposit of cost is extended by two weeks.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of.
