ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

Petitioner prays for bail pending trial in a criminal case arising out of FIR No.102 dated 24.01.2019 registered under Sections 120-B/406/420 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station, Karnal Sadar, Karnal.

As per the case of the prosecution, Sonu Dhanda along with petitioner and other accused had duped first informant by projecting that they have got import and export license of gold and by purchase and sale of the gold, the first informant can earn huge amount. It is further case of the prosecution that the first informant has been duped of Rs.1,32,00,000/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that case is triable by the Magistrate and the petitioner is in custody for more than 7 months in this case.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Naresh Kumar, has submitted that Sonu Dhanda had formed a gang and there are as many as 13 criminal cases against Sonu Dhanda, whereas

petitioner is an accused in four cases. He has further submitted that large number of complaints have now been recently received against the petitioner by the police.

In view thereof, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
