The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to consider the name of the petitioner for the post of Science Master as well as for appointment.

In the written statement filed on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3, it has been averred that the claim of the petitioner has been considered for the post of Science Master.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been appointed as Science Master. However, the notional pay fixation and the seniority have not been granted to him.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Director Public Instructions (SE), Punjab, Punjab School Education Board Complex, Phase-VIII, SAS Nagar (Mohali) to consider the case of the petitioner for notional pay fixation and the seniority as per merit, in case a representation in this regard is made by the petitioner within three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

The needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners are not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
