This writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the action of the respondents in violating the clauses of 'The Punjab Custom Milling of Paddy Policy (Kharif 2018-19)' (Annexure P-1) for the purpose of allocation of paddy to members of Rice Mills of the Petitioner Association.

Reply on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed and the same is taken on record. As per the reply, a speaking order dated 19.12.2018 (Annexure R-2) has been passed. In pursuance of order dated 21.11.2018, the petitioner appeared before the Committee, constituted to look into the issues. The Committee has reached to the conclusion that sufficient paddy stands stored with the mill of the petitioner i.e. 80.60% of its allocation which is almost near to the paddy allocated to M/s Garg Rice Mill.

In view of the above, the grievance of the petitioner no longer subsists.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner states that liberty may be given to lay challenge to the speaking order (Annexure R-2).

The present petition stands disposed of with liberty aforesaid.
