Petitioner participated in the selection process for the post of Conductor under SC category, pursuant to advertisement dated 18.05.2017 (Annexure P-1). Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per OMR sheet, petitioner has secured 140 marks and the last candidate, who has been called for interview under the SC category, has secured 134 marks.

Learned State counsel has informed that the final result has been declared on 02.12.2018 and the last candidate selected under the SC category has secured 154 marks. Candidates who have secured upto 152 marks, have been kept in the waiting list.

Result of the petitioner has been produced in Court today, a perusal of which shows that he (petitioner) has secured 132 marks in written examination and 10 in viva voce, total 142 marks. Meaning thereby, petitioner has secured less marks than the last candidate in the waiting list also. Hence, he is not entitled to be appointed on the aforesaid post.

Resultantly, the present petition is dismissed.
