TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner filed the instant petition seeking a mandamus for directing the respondent-authorities to waive the condition of completion of one year of internship ending on 31.03.2019.

The case projected on behalf of the petitioner was that as on the cut off date i.e. 31.03.2019, she was falling short of only two days in relation to the requirement of internship of one year and that also on account of reasons and circumstances beyond her control.

On a previous date of hearing i.e. 11.12.2018, interim directions were issued permitting the petitioner to appear in the NEET PG 2019 Examination subject to the outcome of the writ petition. It was further directed that mere participation in the examination would not vest any equitable rights in her favour and that her result would not be declared without leave of this Court.

On 29.01.2019 Mr.Sumeet Goel, Advocate representing respondent No.2 had been directed to furnish the result of the petitioner in a sealed cover.

In compliance of the order dated 29.01.2019, Mr.Goel has furnished result of the petitioner pertaining to NEET PG 2019 in a sealed cover.

The same has been opened. Petitioner who belongs to the General Category has secured 120 marks out of 1200 and her NEET PG 2019 rank is reflected as 135561.

Confronted with such dismal performance of the petitioner in the NEET PG 2019 Examination, counsel prays for withdrawal of the writ petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
