The short grievance raised in the petition is that inspite of having necessary permission/authority/licence under the provisions of the Lotteries (Regulations) Act 1998 and Lotteries (Regulations) Rules 2010 and the Punjab State Lotteries Regulation Rules, the petitioners are not being permitted to run the lottery business from their shops/stalls within the District Sangrur, State of Punjab.

Having heard counsel for the petitioners at length and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, liberty is granted to the petitioners to agitate their grievance before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur/respondent No.3 alongwith all supporting/relevant document in support of their contention that they are duly authorized and they are licence holders to run the lottery business.

In the eventuality of any such application, being submitted, by the petitioners, respondent No.3 would be obligated to examine the matter

and thereafter to take steps as he may deem fit in accordance with law.

Petition disposed of.
