Learned counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to consider and decide the representation dated 20.08.2019 (Annexure P-6) submitted by him, within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the representation dated 20.08.2019 (Annexure P-6) pragmatically within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order after affording opportunity to the petitioner. He would be at liberty to raise all the points. Petitioner is at liberty to make arrangement with regard to joining or otherwise.

It is made clear that in case the representation is not decided within fifteen days, there shall be costs of ₹ 25,000/- to be paid to the petitioner.
