The grievance of the petitioner is that though he is not arraigned as an accused in FIR no.67, (registered at Police Station City Raikot, District Ludhiana, on 3.8.2019), alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, he is being summoned time and again by respondents no.3 and 4, without following due process of law.

In respect of his grievance, he is stated to have made a representation to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, on 12.8.2019, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition.

Consequently, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, i.e. respondent no.2, to go into the grievance of the petitioner and ensure that if at all he is to be summoned in connection with the commission of any crime by any person, he shall only be summoned by due process of law as laid down in the Cr.P.C., and not

otherwise.
