The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the official respondents No.2 to 4 to hand over the physical possession of the mortgaged property to the petitioner.

2. On 22.02.2019, respondent No.6 had appeared in Court in compliance of order dated 12.02.2019 and made a statement that he has no objection for delivering the physical possession of the secured asset. Accordingly, respondent No.4 was directed to deliver the physical possession of the mortgaged asset i.e. House No.107, HB 152, Khata No.69/101 (New Khata No.76/107) Khasra No.64, Dharampur Colony, Pinjore, District Panchkula.

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, respondent No.4 has submitted a compliance report according to which the possession of the mortgaged asset was delivered to the petitioner on 25.02.2019. The same is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in view of the above, the present petition has become infructuous may be disposed of as such.
