JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to the respondents to make payment of rent of Rs.9,63,800/- alongwith interest as per the agreement dated 1.4.2014 (Annexure P-1).

Despite repeated opportunities, no reply has been filed by the respondents.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice dated 4.10.2018 (Annexure P-6) expeditiously.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice dated 4.10.2018 (Annexure P-6) in accordance with law within six weeks from the date of receipt of the

certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
