The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.249 dated 12.06.2019, under Sections 420,467,468,471,120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Section 63 of Copy Right Act, 1957 and Section 61 of Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Safidon, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that recovery of liquor was effected from the rented premises of co-accused Anil Kumar @ Kala Shah. The petitioner is not named in the FIR and no recovery has been effected from the petitioner. The petitioner is not involved in any other case. He also contends that co-accused, namely, Anil Kumar @ Kala Shah has been granted bail by this Court in CRM-M No.34030 of 2019 on 06.09.2019.

This Court, by the order dated 29.08.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim

bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Parveen Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the order dated 29.08.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
