Amol Rattan Singh, J. (Oral):

Learned State counsel on instructions from the police official who is present in Court to assist him, submits that pursuant to the order of this Court dated October 18, 2019, the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required presently.

That being so, this petition is allowed, with the order dated October 18, 2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

However, the aforesaid order will not be treated to be an observation of this Court on the merits of the case, but only in view of the fact that the investigating agency itself has stated that it does not require

custodial interrogation of the petitioners.

Naturally, the complainant would be at liberty to avail of his remedy as regards any grievance, including the investigation process.
