This order shall dispose of COCP Nos. 2921, 2922, 3022, 3023 &
3032 of 2019 as the similar issue is involved therein.

The petitioners filed writ petition raising grievance that no decision

The petitions were disposed of on the statement made by the learned
State counsel that the concerned authority shall consider the matter and pass a
order within one month.

Learned State counsel submits that the claim of the petitioners raised
in the Legal Notice has been accepted and monetary benefits stand paid.

disputing the said fact.

In view of the above, the contempt petitions are disposed of as
infructuous. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail remedies in
