The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.106 dated 26.04.2019 registered under Sections 379-B, 511, 34 IPC at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The operative part of the order dated 29.08.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that there is a delay of 03 days in registration of the FIR and as per the allegations in the FIR, after the incident has occurred in which 04 persons tried to loot Rs.80,000/- from the petitioner, he was searching them at his own and then came to know that the names of the accused are Navkiran named as Gullu in the FIR, Dalbir @ Dulla, Gopi and Paramjit Singh. It is further submitted that even as per the allegations, the aforesaid 04 persons had left one motorcycle at the spot but the petitioner approached the

police after a period of 03 days by making a story.

Notice of motion for 17.09.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 29.08.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 29.08.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
