Petitioner-Sourabh Dhanda has prayed for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.158 dated 11.4.2019 under Sections 323, 325, 34, 341, 427 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station HTM, Hisar, District Hisar.

The FIR was registered on the statement of Balwant Singh wherein it was alleged that he was running a Mess in the Boys Hostel of Guru Jambheshwar University, Hisar. On 10.4.2019 at about 9.10 p.m., when he was coming from Jahajpul to Thandi Road, three boys who were on a motorcycle came from behind and made him to stop his car and one of the boys hit the front glass of the car with an iron rod. The other person came from the side and opened the front door of the car and started hitting upon his legs with an iron rod. The complainant was taken to the hospital by his brother Pawan Kumar. It was explained that one Sunil lived in the hostel alongwith his brother Anil who had not cleared the dues of the Mess for the last one year and the same was conveyed by the complainant to their father.

According to the complainant, Sourabh Dhanda, petitioner caused injuries at the instance of Sunil and Anil.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has no motive to cause injuries as it was the other accused who were involved in the crime. He submits that the petitioner was neither the student nor residing in the hostel.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not find it a fit case for grant of extraordinary concession of pre-arrest bail, particularly when the complainant has named the petitioner. The nature of injuries suffered by the petitioner is serious as he suffered multiple fractures.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to grant pre-arrest bail.

Petition is dismissed.
