Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to consider and decide the premature release case of the petitioner, which is already pending with the respondents since 08.10.2018, as the petitioner has undergone more sentence that is required for consideration of his premature case.

A bare perusal of the reply, which is submitted by Sh. Rahul Raja, Deputy Superintendent, Maximum Security Jail, Nabha, that the premature release case of the petitioner was initiated by the Superintendent, District Jail, Sangrur vide office letter No. 4282-84 dated 08.10.2018 (Annexure R-1/T) to the District Magistrate, Sangrur to obtain the verification report of the local police authorities, after the petitioner fulfilled the mandatory conditions required vide Punjab Government Pre-Mature release policy dated 08.07.1991, para No.1.i Column 'c' on completion of 10 years actual sentence and 14 years sentence including remission and excluding parole.

The petitioner was transferred from District Jail, Sangrur to this jail on 21.11.2018.

It seems that the District Magistrate, Sangrur and Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur have kept the proceedings in abeyance and failed to submit the verification report with regard to the premature release case of the petitioner.

In view of the above, respondent No.1 is directed to submit a verification report and decide the premature case of the petitioner expeditiously preferably within a period of 60 days, as per law, after the receipt of certified copy of this order.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
