Present petition has been filed under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ for setting aside the impugned selection list (Annexure P-3), vide which the respondent no.4 has been selected for the post of Constable in Punjab Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that private respondent no.4 has been given 15 marks for being 6 feet tall whereas petitioner has been given 14 marks for being 5' 11 ³/₄ ". He further contends that the private respondent is infact 5'11".

On a query being posed by the Court as to how he knows the height of the said respondent, he submits that he is native of the same village as the petitioner and he has throughout known him and therefore knows this.

This Court in writ jurisdiction cannot go into it. The height has been measured by the competent persons / medical board constituted for the purposes and the criteria of constituting such a medical board is not under

Being devoid of merit, writ petition is accordingly dismissed.
