Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly states that the benefits for which the present writ petition was filed, have already been released but after an unreasonable delay and therefore, petitioner is entitled for interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that liberty be granted to the petitioner to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation/legal notice and for the grant of interest, petitioner has served upon the respondents with a legal notice dated 03.07.2019, which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the respondents be directed to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the respondents very fairly states that in case any legal notice dated 03.07.2019 claiming interest, has been received by the department, the same will be decided within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order, by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In case, the claim of the petitioner is accepted by the respondents as per the order to be passed, the benefits so accruing to the

petitioner in respect of the interest, be released to her within a period of one month of the passing of the order.

The present writ petition stands disposed of in above terms.
