B.S. Walia, J. (Oral)

[1] Sole prayer is for correcting the name of the petitioner's father recorded as Jeetinder S. Grewal to read as Jeetinder Singh Grewal in the Matriculation, as well as Class 10+2 certificate issued by the CBSE. Apparently, the particulars of the petitioner's father name, as recorded in the Matriculation and Class 10+2 certificates are a typographical error, since in the transfer certificate i.e., Annexure P-16 dated 29.05.2008 at page No.52 of the paper book, the petitioner's father's name is mentioned as Jeetinder Singh Grewal. Likewise, in Annexure P-18 i.e. the registration form dated 20.03.2008, which was submitted by the respondent-School to the CBSE, the name of the petitioner's father is mentioned as Jeetinder Singh Grewal.

[2] Reply has not been filed. Learned counsel for respondent No.2/CBSE has not been able to controvert the aforementioned factual position

and states that in the circumstances, he does not oppose the prayer for

correction of the name of the petitioner's father as per details given in registration form (Annexure P-18) dated 20.03.2008 and admission form (Annexure P-19) dated 28.03.2008 since apparently, the name of the petitioner's father as recorded in the Matriculation and Class 10+2 certificate issued by the CBSE appears to be an inadvertent typographical error. He, however, prays that this order be not treated as a precedent.

[4] In the light of statement of learned counsel for the respondent CBSE and the position as noted above, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing the CBSE to take appropriate steps to issue fresh Matriculation and 10+2 certificate, reflecting the name of the petitioner's father as Jeetinder Singh Grewal as per registration form (Annexure P-18) as well as admission form (Annexure P-19).

[5] Needful be done in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible, preferably within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

[6] However, this order shall not be treated as a precedent.
