This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent Nos. 1 to 7 to take stern and immediate action against respondent No.8 for violation of statutory provisions.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.4- District Collector, Mewat, District Mewat to consider and decide the representations dated 27.02.2018, 07.03.2018 and 15.03.2018 (Annexure P-8 colly) expeditiously.

Learned State counsel has no objection to the prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4- District Collector, Mewat, District Mewat to consider and decide the representations dated 27.02.2018, 07.03.2018 and 15.03.2018 (Annexure P-8 colly) within eight weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. An effective opportunity of hearing be also afforded to the petitioner. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to her, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to her, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter, in accordance with law.
