This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 73, dated 14.4.2019, registered under Sections 323/34/392/394/452/506 IPC at Police Station Sector 14, Panchkula, District Panchkula.

Allegations in the FIR against petitioner are that when complainant was doing rest after taking food at his shop alongwith his son and brother in law, petitioner alongwith unknown persons came there and entered his shop. They caught hold of his collar after using filthy language and started beating him. When his brother in law and son tried to get him released, Diwakar gave blow punch on forehead and right eye of complainant. Thereafter, Harikesh, Sonu alias Naatu, Monu and others also gave slaps and fist blows on him. When his brother came there, Monu gave a danda blow on his back and Sonu alias Naatu gave stone blow on his mouth.

The learned counsel for petitioner submits that injuries received by complainant and others are simple in nature.

Vide order dated 29.8.2019, this Court, while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail, directed petitioner to join investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harinder Singh, states that petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of above, petition is allowed. The order dated 29.8.2019, granting interim anticipatory bail to petitioner, is made absolute. However, petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
