Petitioner is a *Lambardar* of village Saidpura, Tehsil Khamanon, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

His grievance is that no action is being taken by the Gram Panchayat, District Administration for removing the illegal encroachments/possession of the private respondents 8 to 14, namely, Bant Singh, Balbir Singh, Lakhvir Singh, Lakhmir Singh @ Lakhvir Singh, Joga Singh, Jodh Singh and Harpal Singh from the land belonging to the State Government situated within the revenue estate of village Khamanon.

In view of the factual contentions, the State Counsel was directed to obtain specific instructions after examination of the revenue

records.

At the time of resumed hearing today, learned State Counsel on instructions from Mr. Rupinder Singh, Naib Tehsildar, Khamanon states that the proceedings under The Punjab Public Premises and Land (Eviction and Rent Recovery) Act, 1973 have since been initiated against the private respondents.

In view of the above, it is conceded that the primary grievance of the petitioner stands satisfied.

Disposed of as infructuous.
