Prayer in the present petition is to grant regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 84 dated 21.9.2015 registered under Sections 323, 367, 506, 34 IPC and Section 3 of the Schedule Caste and Schedule Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is in custody since 17.4.2019 and in fact there is a settlement between the parties because of which first informant i.e Karnail Singh and Manjit Singh eye witness have not supported the case set up by the prosecution.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Ramesh Kumar submits that petitioner was declared proclaimed offender on 17.1.2017 and was arrested on 18.4.2019.

Be that as it may, the petitioner has already suffered incarceration for a period of 4 and ½ months.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, in the considered view of the Court, petitioner deserves the concession of bail and therefore, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
