The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 123 dated 12.6.2019, registered under Sections 420 and 406 IPC, at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda.

Learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Surinder Pal Rana, submits that there have been as many as 7 more cases of similar nature against the petitioner out of which some are still pending at the stage of trial. List of cases has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. Even in the present case, there are specific allegations against the petitioner and the police would be required to conduct the thorough investigation; to unearth the true dimensions of the alleged crime.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
