Claim in the present petition is for considering the petitioner to seek appointment on compassionate ground, as a special case, like it was done in the case of appointment of one Ajay Kumar son of Harbhajan Lal Khullar (Retd. Inspector) to the post of ASI. Petitioner's father met with an accident on 08.09.2014 while in service and suffered memory loss. He retired as Sub-Inspector on 31.07.2015.

2. In this regard, petitioner submitted various representations dated 18.01.2017 and 20.07.2017 and 08.01.2019 respectively to the respondents but the same have not been adverted to by the respondents. Hence, the writ petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of the petition, Mr. P.S.Bajwa,

Additional A.G. Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the State.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representations dated 18.01.2017, 20.07.2017 and 08.01.2019 (Annexures P-9, P-10, P-13) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
