TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

It is inter alia contended that petitioner No.1, who is a lady, aged 80 years and her son/petitioner No.2, aged 42 years are being harassed by the officials of Police Station Women Cell, District Amritsar Rural at the behest of private respondents No.4 to 8.

Counsel would submit that matrimonial relations between petitioner No.2 and his wife i.e. respondent No.4 are not cordial. Respondent No.6 is a Constable in Punjab Police and at his behest, the petitioners are being repeatedly called to the Police Station and are being harassed and victimized.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to disposed of the instant writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural as regards their grievance.

In the eventuality of any such application being preferred,

respondent No.2 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
