TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA.J.

Petitioner has filed the instant petition seeking a mandamus for directing respondent-Central Board of Secondary Education (for short, CBSE') to carry out the correction in her Matriculation Certificate and for the name of her mother to read as 'Rajinder Kaur' instead of 'Rajwinder Kaur'.

Pleadings on record would indicate that the concerned official under the CBSE had called upon the Principal of the school where the petitioner was studying to furnish certain documents in support of the correction that was being sought.

As per counsel representing the petitioner, the necessary documents were furnished on 20.07.2018.

Counsel representing the respondent-Board does not dispute such factual premise.

The respondent-Board has till date not taken a final decision on the request of the petitioner seeking the correction afore-noticed.

In view of the above, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition with a direction to the competent authority under the CBSE to take a final decision in the matter and pass an order in accordance with law and to convey the same to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today.

The writ petition is disposed of.

The pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
