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**RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL):**

This is a petition by mother of a girl, namely, Manpreet Kaur, who was allegedly minor and a male child was born of a relationship with Chamkaur Singh. Manpreet Kaur is present in the Court with Chamkaur Singh. The couple says that they are married. The child, namely, Surajdeep Singh is about two years old, at present.

As per the directions of this Court, dated 04.12.2018, Chamkaur Singh has deposited a sum of Rs.90,000/- in a Fixed Deposit which is short by Rs.10,000/-. This shortfall does not appear to be of much significance since the couple appears to be happily married. The amount has been deposited in Post Office Savings Account. The fact that the marriage is working and the couple is happy with their son, no further orders are required in this petition. As far as the FIR is concerned, the parties may take resort to their remedies as available in law to put an end to the thorn in their matrimonial life.

The petition stands disposed of.
