RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (Oral)

1. The educational certificates of higher qualifications were not mentioned or revealed at the time of appointment as Chowkidar on the establishment of this Court. Petitioner has concealed the material facts by not disclosing his educational qualifications as B.A. and M.A. earned prior to appointment. Such qualifications cannot be relied on to jump seniority and gain promotion and other service benefits based on educational qualifications.

2. Previously, the petitioner had filed CWP-13623-2016 which was dismissed as withdrawn by order dated 14.07.2016 without liberty to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action. This is the second reason why I would decline to interfere in the matter. Normally, I would have

imposed costs on the petitioner for not highlighting the fact of dismissal of

the writ petition in the material paragraphs of the petition and/or in the list of events but the fact that it has been mentioned in formal paragraph 15 of the petition at Page 28, I refrain from imposing costs.

3. Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.
