Petitioner, a young boy of 21 years, prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.104, dated 01.07.2019, registered under Sections 307/341/506/34 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Radaur, Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in fact the parties have settled their dispute. He draws attention of the court to the order dated 15.07.2019, passed in CRM-M-29462-2019. He further submits that it is a case of no injury to the first informant.

Petitioner is in custody since 02.07.2019. Investigations are complete and the challan has been presented.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 02.07.2019 and the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
