Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 46 dated 12.08.2019 under Sections 22 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Dharamgarh, District Sangrur.

Vide order dated 26.09.2019, this Court while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to join the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI, Kewal Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 26.09.2019 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
