Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0046 dated 21.07.2018 under Sections 363, 366-A IPC, registered at Police Station Bhaini Mian Khan, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner and daughter of the complainant have solemnized marriage and they have been blessed with a child(male). They are staying together as husband and wife. This fact is not disputed by learned State Counsel, of course on instructions from ASI Jagdish Singh.

Vide order dated 29.08.2019, this Court had stayed arrest of the petitioner. As the petitioner and daughter of the complainant are staying together as husband and wife, the present petition is disposed of at this

stage, with a direction that the petitioner shall not be arrested in the case unless a clear 15 days' notice is served upon him, enabling him to avail the legal recourse.
