Appellants have filed this appeal for enhancement. While praying for enhancement, learned counsel submitted that even though it is recorded that the deceased must be earning an handsome amount, only ₹8,000/- per month has been assessed as his income, whereas it should have been ₹15,000/-. However, there is nothing on record to enable this Court to assess the income of the deceased and in the absence of any evidence qua same, the earning having been assessed @ ₹8,000/- per month, cannot be interfered with.

Dismissed.
