Today in Court short reply dated 22.11.2019 by way of affidavit of Mr. Rakesh Agrawal, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, is filed, taken on record and copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

CRM-M-32330 of 2019 was filed by the petitioner for providing security. The petition was disposed of on 5.8.2019 with a direction to the respondents to take decision on the grievance of the petitioner as per law.

The present petition is filed pleading that needful has not been done.

In the reply, it is stated that PCS squads of the area has been directed to keep strict surveillance of the house of the petitioner and apart

from this, ACP West and ADCP-III have been directed to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Inspector-Paramdeep Singh submits that as per the directions issued, ACP West and ADCP-III are looking into the threat perception from their own angle and in case any action is required, the same would be taken immediately.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of.
