The petitioners inter alia have approached this Court by filing writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to accept the One Time Settlement against the loan amount by the petitioners and in nature of certiorary for quashing the notices dated 20.05.2016 (Annexure P-3), 08.08.2016 (Annexure P-6) and 05.06.2017 (Annexure P-7) and its consequential proceedings of selling the residential house by way of E-auction, which is being erroneous, highly improper and illegal manner.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail the alternative remedies as are available to them in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be, available to them, in accordance with law.
