The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.20 dated 22.01.2019, under Sections 177, 199, 200, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had impersonated as Ganesh while furnishing surety bonds. The petitioner is 22 years of age and is in custody for over seven and a half months and is not involved in any other case. There is no allegation that the person for whom the petitioner had stood surety had otherwise escaped or did not appear before the trial Court.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh, states that no prosecution witnesses has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is 22 years old and is in custody for over seven and a half months, he is not involved in any other case and trial

is likely to take sometime, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
