Allowed as prayed for. Reply filed on behalf of the respondents is taken on record.

Main case

Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to re-issue the Passport of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 22.10.2018 (Annexure P-7).

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 22.10.2018 (Annexure P-7) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter, in accordance with law. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
