Petitioners herein seek issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize their services in view of Policy dated 04.03.1999 issued by the Government (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that name of the petitioners have already been recommended for regularization as reflected from seniority list (Annexure P-2) prepared by the department. He further submits that even services of juniors to petitioner No.1 have been regularized.

3. In the premise, petitioners also caused issuance of a legal notice dated 13.05.2019 (Annexure P-7), but the same has not been adverted to till date by the respondents.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On advance service of the petition, Mr. P.S.Bajwa, Additional A.G., Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the State.

6. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

7. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 13.05.2019 (Annexure P-7) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

8. Let the needful be done within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

9. Disposed of in above terms.
