By this petition, filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

The total recovery of poppy husk from the petitioner (as per the case of the prosecution) is 53 kgs., in 4 plastic bags, with the commercial quantity being above 50 kgs, with no other criminal case registered against the petitioner under the NDPS Act, as per the learned State counsel, who says so on instructions of the police official who is present in Court to assist him.

Consequently, without making any comment on the merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to admit him to bail during the pendency of the trial.

The petition is therefore allowed. The petitioner would be enlarged on bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the

satisfaction of the trial Court.
