Pursuant to the order dated 30.8.2019 the report of the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khamanon, dated 16.9.2019, is on record, which eventually states that the application filed by respondent no.2, seeking dismissal of the petition under Section 125 of the Cr.P.C., was allowed, with the said application/petition therefore having been dismissed on 5.9.2019, on the ground that it was not maintainable against the father-in-law of petitioner no.1 (grand father of petitioner no.2).

Obviously, a judicial order having been passed dismissing the said application, this petition has been rendered infructuous, with the petitioners at liberty to challenge the said order as per law.

However, even while disposing off this petition as having been rendered infructuous, the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khamanon, is directed to ensure that she at least reads the report that she is signing to be put up before this Court, with even the date given at two places not having been seen by her.

The learned Sessions Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib, is directed to convey the displeasure of this Court to the said judicial officer, as regards not even looking at the report properly, that she has signed.

A report by the learned Sessions Judge, stating as to whether or not this order has been conveyed to her, be put up by 16.10.2019.
